## Customized Solutions

### Regulatory Compliance

- HSC established and administered a Project Management Office (PMO) to develop a consistent methodology across all projects for the California Office of HIPAA Compliance.

### Information Security Management

- Working for CDHS, the HSC team implemented our proprietary Security Management Tool, which enables collection of component data for assessment and analysis. We employed an Annualized Loss Expectancy (ALE) model to identify and measure the costs associated with potential security failures. HSC calculated these costs and weighed them against the cost of safeguards, giving a Return on Investment view of security management practices and setting the stage for prioritizing future security management actions, funding and staffing requirements.

### Outcomes Measurement Systems

- The California Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) faced the difficulty of implementing a program that could generate outcomes measurement data that would meet federal guidelines, as well as yield accurate data to help shape future AOD treatment policy. HSC and Natoma Systems developed, tested and deployed statewide a cohesive, functional system for California's counties.

### Information Systems Development

- The California Department of Health Services (CDHS) oversees the California Medicaid Management Information System (CA-MMIS). Electronic Data Systems (EDS) is the fiscal intermediary responsible for running this complex system. Facing complex system enhancements, with a tight deadline.
